

And it is now more important than ever, as we have an effective management option.


MCI vs EARLY AD

Mild Cognitive Impairment (MCI) or prodromal Alzheimer's disease is a condition in which individuals demonstrate cognitive impairment with no or minimal impairment of Instrumental Activities of Daily Living (IADL). Early Alzheimer's disease is when IADL becomes impaired.
